English Introduction

This is a very beautiful and deeply reaching munajaat of Mawlana Ali (as) that we recite during the time of istiftah namaz. With utmost humility Mawlana Ali (as) reaches out in supplication to Allah Ta'aala, with no goal but to be with Allah, and no other intention. To be able to do Munajaat is a great fortune for the Mumin. In this Munajaat Mawlana Ali (as) shows us how when the servant of Allah prays Munajaat near Allah with sincerity of heart and of soul, how he is graced by Allah's beneficence. Allah tells his servant to have no fear, no anxiety, that the voice of his prayers towards him are sought after by the angels and his prayers are before Him. He says to his servant, 'I hear you and answer you my servant, you are in my care, ask that whatever you wish, Indeed I am Allah.'
